FISHERY RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No fires
2. No bait boats
3. Fish to be kept in retainers for a minimum of 10 minutes after capture
4. All anglers must have an appropriate sized unhooking mat and a landing net of at least 42"
5. Maximum stay 72 hours, followed by at least 48 hours away from the lake
6. No leaving tackle unattended. One trip away from the lake of 90 minutes maximum is permitted per session. No reserving of swims is allowed
7. Fishing with 3 rods maximum, from designated swims only
8. All nut baits are banned
9. Under 18's must be accompanied by an adult
10. No leadcore or fixed leads
11. No non-fishing guests
12. All litter is to be removed from the lake. Any member found leaving any litter either around the lake or in the car park will automatically lose their permit
13. Permit holders must carry their permits with them and be prepared to produce their permit on request from any bailiff or member
14. All vehicles must be parked in the designated car park, not by the lakeside
15. Any permit holder acting in an unsportsmanlike or inconsiderate manner is liable to have their permit withdrawn
16. Boats to be used for landing fish only. Any boat is used at the risk of members or guests. If you have any concerns about your ability to use a boat then we would recommend that you refrain from doing so. Life jackets must be worn, and the condition of the boat checked before use.
17. Neither the company nor its servants shall be held responsible for any loss or damage to, or theft of, property howsoever caused. Ticket holders are not entitled to make any claims against the company or any of its servants or agents in respect of any such loss, damage, theft or injury
18. We ask that you show the utmost respect to our surrounding neighbours when entering or leaving the lake
19. The company reserves the right to withdraw permits at its absolute discretion and in that event all rights of the former permit holder shall immediately cease and no refund of any monies paid shall be made
